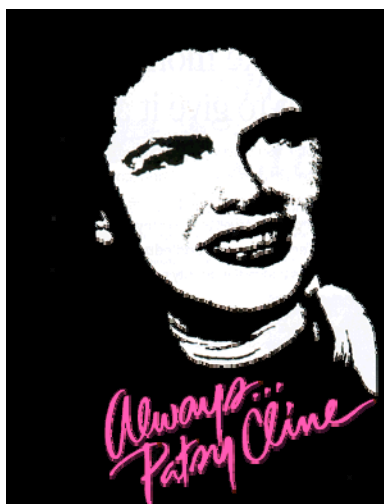

It has been one of the most produced musicals in America according to *American Theatre Magazine*. "*Always...Patsy Cline*" has also been enjoyed internationally by audiences in Canada, the UK and Australia.

"*Always...Patsy Cline*" is more than a tribute to the legendary country singer who died tragically at age 30 in a plane crash in 1963.
